

- C. Children are required to be fever free for 48 hours before returning to the center. With no medication (within 24 hours of returning to school).
- D. If your child becomes ill while at daycare and in the parent or authorized person cannot be notified and emergency treatment is necessary, the child will be taken to the emergency room, or to the child's personal physician by the director, a teacher, or an ambulance.
- E. If it is absolutely necessary, medication will be given at the center, but only when the required authorization form is completed. Medication must be in the original container and with the child's name and dosage. The medication must be in a zip lock bag and cannot contain fever reducing agents of any kind.

X. CHILDREN'S SUPPLIES

Parents are requested to label and supply the following items necessary for the proper care of your child:

1. A full extra set of-clothes.
2. Wipes (infant and toddlers}
3. Diapers (infants and toddlers)
4. Formula and baby food for infants, (if the child eats table food it will be provided by First Steps.)
